## Reports on garden sites:

<u>Kremmling:</u> The potatoes for the dinner are doing well, Gracen continues to weed and work on the beds. There is some indication of activity from other gardeners because the gate has been left open but Travis is not certain who to attribute that to.

<u>Fraser:</u> The ventilation system is almost finished they are just waiting for the electrical contractor to finish hooking it up. They had an irrigation leak. All the beds have been planted and look good.

Granby: The gardens are doing great. Patty has decided to eliminate the compost piles, as they

have been difficult to maintain. Gardeners have had quite a few vole problems so they have been trapping them. The garden no longer has a regular mowing person. Travis will speak to a family that has a middle school student that may be interested. Patty has some concern that the carrots may not be ready for the upcoming Garden to Table dinner. She has planned to experiment with transplanting some from other gardens and has planted some additional short-season seed.

<u>Hot Sulphur Springs:</u> There have been several nights of frost which has damaged the potatoes and other crops. In anticipation of selling the compost bin it has been emptied. Merilyn will contact Caroline about the process for selling it. Leslie has planted community beds with potatoes, herbs & greens.

## **Old Business:**

<u>Update of invoice from Sky Hi News:</u> The price has still not been properly adjusted to reflect the smaller size ad and non-profit pricing. The Extension office has informed Sky-Hi that they will not pay until instructed by the board. Patty will follow-up with Debbie.

<u>Update of Garden to Table Dinner:</u> Patty has had a good communication about the event, they seem very excited. Patty will get a time line and a produce quantity update before the next meeting. She will also work on the flyer and send it out via email. Travis will have two pigs to supply. They're using a new processor this year.
